Phil the Bag - drop off bags Tuesday 1st December afternoon at bike shed area, collection Wednesday 2nd December

As you dig out your winter wardrobe, if you have any clothing, bed linen, towels, curtains, shoes or bags that you don't want anymore please fill a bag and bring it in. It's such an easy way to raise funds for the school and we need at least 40 bags to qualify for a collection. As you know, the Government is clamping down on the use of plastic bags, and in line with their updated Environmental Policy, Phil The Bag have taken the decision to no longer provide bags to schools/organisations. Consequently, please use your own bags (black sacks, bin liners, carrier bags etc.,) and they will recycle these for you. Before preparing bags for drop off on the 1st December please take a minute to read through the following of what is now included and excluded from the Phil the Bag collection:



# Phil the Bag - what is included and excluded for collection

Phil the Bag *accepts* all kinds of adult and children's clothing, hats, shoes, belts, handbags, school uniform and household textiles including sheets, pillow cases, duvet covers, curtains and towels. Please bear in mind that clothing is for re-use so should be in a wearable condition.

Phil the Bag <u>does not accept</u> blankets, bric-a-brac, duvets, pillows, sleeping bags, rugs, carpet, offcuts of fabric, any wet items, tent canvas, no ripped or stained clothing. Unfortunately we are <u>also unable to accept</u> towels, bedding and curtains from commercial organisations eg, hospitals, hotels and animal sanctuaries.

Please drop off bags from pick up time on Tuesday 1st December at the bike shed area.
