FUNDRAISING UPDATE

<u>What we Raised:</u> We raised £2,670 last term from the Summer BBQ, £1,031 from the Parents' Skool Disco and £1,665 for the Talents, which made a yearly grand total of £15,700 - well done and a huge thank you. <u>What we have spent:</u> The good news is that all your hard work and generosity over the last year means that the PTA has been able to fund several big-ticket items in the last few months, including the brand new 'Boaty' climbing frame, some new gazebos for our fundraising events and the much needed new PTA shed. In total last year we raised £3,400 more than the previous year, mostly due to new events, which is just fabulous – thank you!

Fireworks Spectacular – Thursday 2nd November 6.00-8.00pm : The first event of the year is definitely the noisiest but also the brightest and one that the children really enjoy. This year's Fireworks Spectacular is set to be as exciting as ever - tickets cost £15 in advance for a family of four from www.thelittleboxoffice.com/busbridgejuniorpta Buying tickets early helps us to ensure we have enough goodies for everyone, so go for it!
