receive a World Book Day £1 book token to use towards buying a new book, or in exchange for a free World Book Day book.


Parents' Evenings - Monday 13th 6.00-8.30pm & Tuesday 14th March 4.00pm-6.30pm

The next Friends meeting will take place on Tuesday 25th April from 7.00pm.


Lunch Money

Sainsbury's Active Kids Vouchers and PE Kit Reminder


