- Click on Create an account
- Support a good cause
- In the name box type Busbridge Junior
- Select that cause from the drop down box
- Support this cause
- Join with either email or Facebook
- Input details (name, email, password)
- Click Create Account and you are finished and ready to shop.

Once set-up every time you online shop click through the Easyfundraising website. So you don't forget to use it, delete all quick links/apps from IPhone/iPad of the shops you buy from online. Then book mark the Easyfundraising website to your screen. This means you go through their site first before making any online purchases. You could also delete all of your favourite retailers on your computer and just have this one favourite for your online purchases. Amongst the retailers on Easy Fundraising are: Amazon, John Lewis, Sainsbury, Argos, M&S, Next, Boots, Ocado and that's in addition to hotels, flights and also some business items - WE CAN'T GO WRONG if we all shop the 'Easy' way.

When you click the link it's just a case of entering the name of the retailer you want and it then takes you to that website. Navigating it this way means Easyfundraising knows about the transaction and credits the donation from that retailer to the PTA account. The Easyfundraising website also keeps a total of all of your donations.

Thank you for sticking with this, and taking the time to read our newsletter. Let's look forward to a week 'off', followed by loads of fun in the run up to Christmas and the excitement at our two really big events.
