School Drop Off time - 8.45am



Please can I remind you that school drop-off time in the morning is 8.45am. The playground is not supervised until 8.45am and so for health and safety reasons we do not want children dropped off before 8.45am. If you require childcare

before this time we offer our breakfast club facility which you can book into by contacting Mrs Jackie McPhail. Details can be found overleaf on this newsletter. Please ensure all absences are reported by phone to the school office by 9.15am latest.

School Uniform

The children are looking very smart at the beginning of the school year in their Autumn/Winter school uniform. Please can all children wear smart school uniform every day and ensure it is named. Please see the information below about Stikins Labels which the Friends have linked up with as a way to raise funds and not lose uniform! Please can I remind you of a couple of uniform rules as follows::

- The children should wear black school shoes and not trainers
- Girls need to have longer hair tied back
- No nail varnish to be worn in school
- If wearing earrings these need to be simple studs. Earrings must be taken out for PE and swimming lessons a secure container is advisable to put them in to keep them safe. If having ears pierced we recommend this is done at the start of the summer holidays to allow time for the ears to heal.

Please ensure all the children are in full school uniform including ties and jumpers/cardigans for the school photographer on Monday 18th September.

PF Kit

To participate fully in PE lessons in the appropriate clothing, please can you ensure the children have their PE kit in school. We do encourage the children to keep their PE kit in school all week rather than take it home so they don't forget it. We have been talking about responsibility in assembly and getting the children to take responsibility for their PE kit is a great way to help develop this!



Parentmail PMX

As emailed earlier this week, we are in the process of setting up Parentmail PMX to communicate with Parent Mai parents via email and texts. Please ensure you are registered and keep your contact details up to date. If you do change any contact details the school office must be informed so that our records are also kept up

to date. We will be sending out data collection sheets next week for parents to check all personal, contact and medical records we have for your child are correct.

School Meals

For your information, school meals are entered on Parentmail PMX a week in advance. Please note any absences will not be charged. If your child wishes to change their meal choice a weeks' notice needs to be given to the school office.

No doubt your child will be tired after their first full week back after the holidays, so do enjoy a restful weekend (if possible!) ahead of more engaging learning at Busbridge CE Junior School next week.
