Anti-Bullying Week

This week has nationally been anti-bullying week. The Head teacher's assembly on Monday launched the theme in our school. During the week the children have been



exploring the theme in their classes with a number of activities including circle time discussion, designing anti-bullying leaflets and posters, and exploring our anti-bullying policy. These activities have been designed to help develop the children's understanding of what bullying is, and ways to get help with bullying related issues. was the first in Brighton to receive electricity) demonstrating their skills in many activities such as polishing silver, laying a five course place setting and even preparing jam tarts! Half of the day was also spent at the Hove museum where real Victorian artefacts were available for the children to explore and experience. Overall a fantastic day was had by all, and the children were a huge asset to the school with their enthusiastic participation and excellent behaviour. A tremendous thank you to all the parents and carers at home for preparing the children's brilliant costumes, and to the parents who were able to come along and help on us the trip.
