# **FUNDRAISING UPDATE**

<u>Christmas Fayre:</u> You raised a whopping £3,504 at this year's Fayre. What an amazing amount – Thank You So Much. <u>Phil the Bag:</u> You generated £101.50 from all those kind donations back at the beginning of February. Thank you to Sarah Millar for organising the collection. The next Phil the Bag will be on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June - plenty of time for a presummer sort out. <u>Spring Disco:</u> All those groovy moves on the dancefloor raised an extremely healthy £600. Well done all involved.

<u>What we have spent:</u> So far this year the Busbridge Friends has funded £850 towards the new shed (see below). There are plans afoot for some new gazebos...watch this space.

<u>Update on our new playground:</u> The school is busy working on exciting plans for the playground, to include new play areas, line markings, outdoor learning spaces, a boat themed climbing frame and development of the pond area and produce garden. At the moment we have about £20,000 available in the Friends funds, but the whole project, including the all-important re-surfacing is likely to cost nearer £50,000. So the idea now is to build the playground in stages, with the first stage being the boat themed climbing frame which could be installed during this summer's holidays.
