Welcome back and Happy New Year...

We hope that you all enjoyed a good Christmas break and we welcome you back for the start of the Spring term. Please can we remind you that this term we have an INSET day on Monday 19th February. The focus of our staff training on the INSET day will be on SEND.

Assembly themes for this term:

Over the course of this term we will be revisiting the five fundamental British Values (as outlined by the Department of Education). So far we have reminded ourselves of what they are and discussed what they look like when applied on our playground.

We will also be spending time in assembly discussing our school values (you can find them on our school website via this link:

https://busbridge-junior.eschools.co.uk/web/ethos_and_values/150231). Other themes which we will explore include Friendship and Friends of Jesus (both before half term), then Truthfulness and Easter (both after half term).

Start of the Year Subject Focus Days

On the first two days of this term we spent time focussing on two specific subjects. On Thursday we focussed on PSCHE, and on Friday we focussed on Maths.

On Thursday the children had the opportunity to think about what it means to make a 'fresh start'. They set themselves targets based on their aspirations for the rest of the year, and thought about New Years' resolutions.

On Friday our thoughts turned to maths with the children carrying out a range of maths investigations and activities. On Friday afternoon Mr Evans organised a maths quiz for the Lower and Upper schools. Knowledge of times tables and quick mathematical thinking was required. The quiz was



hotly contested and great fun. It was wonderful to see maths being applauded and celebrated in a very fun and engaging way. The winners earnt points for their houses. Thank you to Mr Evans for all the hard work and time he put into organising the quiz.

Year 3 Fossil Workshop

Yesterday, the Y3 children participated in an excellent fossils workshop led by paleontologist Jules Howard. They looked at animal bones and searched for fossils of prehistoric animals and insects learning all about how they form. The children really impressed him with their intelligent questions. The children all wished it could have gone on longer and commented:

"I saw some ammonite shells which were very swirly" (Amy)

- "I enjoyed looking at Stone Age animal skeletons" (Ben)
- "I liked holding a cave bear skull" (Sadie)

"I enjoyed searching in tree sap for insects like ants and flies" (Tabitha).

Thank you to Mrs Bishop for arranging the visit, and to Jules for once again presenting another brilliant workshop to the children.
