October 2026 Half-Term Survey

As a CofE Aided school we do not need to automatically accept this decision made by Surrey Local Education Authority. It is up to our school Governing body to decide whether we go along with Surrey's decision of 2 weeks, or stick with our current 1 week break. <u>Twelve15 Catering - Proposed Closure</u>

Following a Surrey County Council Cabinet meeting on 23 September, a decision was made to enter a period of consultation and engagement to gain input from staff and schools on the proposal to close catering and equipment maintenance services, provided by Twelve15. The consultation will run until 15 November 2025. If Twelve15 does close, we will of course source new caterers for the school, however it is important to reiterate that no final decision will be made until after the consultation.
