There is an opportunity to join your local on-call fire stations. Surrey Fire and Rescue Service are recruiting locally and are inviting you to join our frontline force saving lives and protecting the Godalming community.

An on-call firefighter has primary employment or other responsibilities but also serves the community and the wider area in which they live or work, educating and protecting the people in that area – people like you and your family.

They respond to a range of emergency fire and rescue incidents and engage in prevention work locally. Full initial and ongoing training is provided, with a weekly training evening that crew members attend. Being an on-call firefighter means people become part of a close-knit team, gaining a range of new skills, earning additional money which fits around existing work and commitments. You will be making a difference and become a valued and respected member within your community.

If you, or anyone you know live or work within 4 minutes of Godalming fire station (GU7 3DU) and are interested in joining our team we would be pleased to hear from you.

You must be at least 18 years old, hold a full current manual driving licence valid for UK use, and have a good level of physical fitness.
