Hepatitis A is a virus that causes serious liver infection and can easily spread from person to person. This virus can make you sick for weeks or months.

How do you get Hepatitis A?



 An infected person not washing their hands after using the bathroom



Drinking or eating food contaminated with Hepatitis A

How can you prevent it?



Get vaccinated for Hepatitis A



Always wash your hands, especially before eating or making food and after using the bathroom.

What are the symptoms?





Jaundice (skin or eyes look yellow)



Dark pee, pale poop or diarrhoea
