Dressed up in authentic Victorian costumes, the children took part in a Victorian school experience, a train ride and a wheel-wright demonstration. The Victorian school experience was popular with the children experiencing bygone teaching methods, writing with slate and chalk and role-playing Victorian punishments. The wheelwright demonstration taught pupils how to make an old fashioned wheel, with pupils even having the opportunity to use tools to help construct a wheel. In addition to the three main activities, the children were given a chance to explore some of the 40,000 artefacts relating to agriculture and rural life.

A huge thank you to the parents for providing such wonderful costumes, to all the parent helpers who joined us on the day and played a vital role in ensuring the trip could occur, and to the Rural Life Centre for giving us such a warm welcome and a great Victorian experience!
