Thursday 15th November: donations for the Children's Secret Shopping Room

Year 5	approx 3-5 pocket money gifts suitable for ladies e.g. bubble bath, nail polish...
Year 6	approx 3-5 pocket money gifts suitable for men e.g. shower gel, socks, keyrings...

Friday 23rd November: donations for the Bottle & Jar Tombola

All year groups – bottles (alcohol, cordial, soft drinks), jars, preserves. Please ensure all bottles and jars are securely sealed. If the item is homemade please label it including when it was made and if possible, include the ingredients. This is to ensure that people with allergies are aware of what is in the produce. Thank you.

Friday 30th November: donations for the Luxury Hamper Raffle

All year groups - luxury non-perishable items for hampers (alcohol, biscuits, crackers, tea/coffee, chutney/marmalade/jams, chocolates, shortbread, Christmas puddings, Christmas crackers, napkins etc..)

Friday 7th December: donations for the Sweetie Tombola & Cake Stall

Years 3 & 4	Cakes and Christmas Bakes (none that contain nuts please)
Years 5 & 6	Sweets for Sweetie Tombola (none that contain nuts please)
