



BUSBRIDGE CofE JUNIOR SCHOOL RULES ON INTERNET USE.

1. Parents/Carers

- Children will only use the Internet for assigned tasks.
- Should any undesirable material appear children must inform an adult immediately. This will allow an address to be taken and the service provider to be informed.
- At no time should children enter a chatroom.
- At no time must children divulge their personal details to any person on the Internet.
- Children will not read e-mails unless directed by an adult.
- Children will only use e-mail when directed to do so by an adult.

I have read the rules and discussed them with my child, who understands and agrees to follow these rules.

2. The Child

- I will use the Internet for the work I am told to do.
- If I see anything children should not see I will inform an adult immediately.
- I will not go into a 'chat room' even if I have a teacher or LSA with me.
- At no time will I give my name address or telephone number to any other person on the Internet.
- I will not read e-mails unless told to by an adult.
- I will only use e-mail when told to by an adult.

I have read the rules and my teacher has explained them to me.

I agree to follow these rules.

I understand that if I do not follow them I may not be allowed to use the Internet again and my parents or carers will be informed.
