We were very lucky and excited to welcome Liam Heath, the Olympic British sprint canoeist, to our assembly this morning to talk to the children and show the gold and silver medals he won in the kayak sprint events at the Rio 2016 Olympics. Liam is a gold medallist in the individual 200m kayak sprint and a silver medallist in the double kayak sprint events. He also won a bronze medal at the London 2012 Olympics in the double kayak sprint event. This was a unique opportunity for Busbridge Junior School, and we are very grateful to Liam for giving up his time to come and see us.

The children have been given a copy of his photo and autograph as a keepsake.
