- You could write a setting description or even a flashback from the modern day picture to the picture from the First World War.

Your writing could include or be entitled:

'From mud, through blood, to the green fields beyond'

All work should be no longer / larger than 1 side of A4 paper and must contain:

- Your name,
- your age,
- your school.
