INSET Day Dates

Please note the INSET day dates for this academic year. The INSET days on 05.11.20 and 26.02.21 have been scheduled by the Godalming Learning Partnership (GLP) for our local schools to work on a shared training project focussing on writing. We appreciate that there are consecutive INSET days in November for Infant and Junior schools. As a group of local Heads we all agreed to this so that the training can be delivered more effectively across KS1 and KS2 settings. Local schools do generally try and keep inset days in line with each other but on this occasion we felt that splitting the training over two inset days (one for KS1, one KS2) would lead to more effective training (and therefore better provision for our children). Thank you for your understanding in this.

Curriculum & Learning Information

At this time of year we usually hold curriculum and learning presentations to inform parents about what the children will be learning in school for the academic year ahead.
