Sickness Policy and Medicines in school

48 hour rule: please can we remind you that if your child is off with sickness (vomiting and/or diarrhoea) please ensure they are off school for 48 hours from the last bout of sickness.

Coughing and sneezing: please encourage your child to cover their mouth and nose with a tissue. Please find attached a letter from the Public Health England with guidance about the Novel Coronavirus situation for your information.

Handwashing: please talk to your child about the importance of washing their hands regularly to help control the spread of infections.

Medicines in school: if your child requires medicine to be administered in school, please ensure a parent/carer brings any medication to (and collects from) the school office in it's original packaging to show what the medication is, dosage instructions and is clearly labelled with the child's name. This includes any creams or cough sweets. A temporary medication form needs to be completed by the parent/carer to be kept with the medication in the school office.
