Christmas Post Box


The Christmas Post box is now available in the school reception for the children to send cards to their friends and teachers. Just a reminder this is an internal postal service and not for sending cards externally!

Watts Gallery Day

Some of our children recently visited Watts Gallery in Compton and had the opportunity to take part in their 'Kids in Museums Takeover Day'. On Friday 15th November year 5 travelled to Brighton and back in time as Victorian servants to spend the day at Preston Manor. They met the butler and other servants who taught them how to perform their daily duties including setting the table, preparing jam tarts, making a scented pomander, polishing the silver and

doing the laundry. The children also visited Hove Museum where they were fascinated by the huge array of Victorian household items. The curator of the museum was very impressed by the children's enthusiasm, curiosity and interesting ideas about what the items could have been used for. What a great trip!
