CHRISTMAS FEEDBACK

- An incredible £4.3k was raised from the Christmas Fair, and an amazing £1.2k was raised from Secret Santa - see Rich's financial update for the breakdown of all monies raised.
- Feedback and ideas to help next year's Christmas fair included: selling tokens in advance of the event; drop the second-hand books and toy stall due to managing the sheer volume of donations when so little is actually sold; make a bigger money tree; re-visit the indoor / outdoor lay out; look into a PRS / PPL licence to play throughout the event.
- Sarah asked all Reps to provide feedback and lessons learnt.
- Positive feedback for the Christmas cards and merchandise, which totalled 335 sales. The personalisation of the products and delivery direct to the buyers were particularly appreciated. Reminder next year for teachers regarding artwork within the set printable boundaries.

MUGA UPDATE

- Fantastic news Godalming Town Council have now donated a grand total of £125k to fund the MUGA. Along with the £25k raised by the PTA, this is likely to cover the costs of this project.
- The Governors / MUGA Working Group are putting in the planning permission and the project will be going to tender in the next 2 3 weeks.
- Work on the project will hopefully start at the end of the summer term.

PTA FUNDING FOR SCHOOL

- Kirsty to invoice Rich for round tables, brushes, books, dictionaries, and anything that has been bought by the school, and has already been pledged by the PTA.
- Richard requested the following, all of which has been approved by the PTA: £1k for ICT equipment; £600 for theatre / music / workshop day; £500 for the school hardship fund; £500 for science equipment; 2 x vented gazebos at circa £160 each; £100 for seeds and plants in the school garden.
- There are plans to a playground upgrade in the near future, which the diocese may help fund this, along with support from the PTA. More information to follow.
