## Work in the school over the holidays

Through the incredible hard work of our Friends of BJS PTA we have been able to significantly improve our ICT learning capabilities over the summer holidays. The PTA have funded a replacement upgrade of the PCs in our Computing suite, along with the installation of a clever touch screen. They have also funded the purchase of 20 Chromebooks. These will be used ASAP by all children across the school.

We have also had a major upgrade of security and safety lighting. This is hopefully something that we will never need to use, but it is there 'just in case'.

# Start of school times / Drop-off arrangements

- 8.50am start (gates open from 8.40am changed from 8.45am): Year 6 and Year 4
- 9.00am start (enter school from 8.50am onwards): Year 5 and Year 3













Please do try and stick to these times as much as possible as arriving early can cause crowding in the small spaces outside the school. Can I also remind you that Years 3 and 4 enter the school through the main gate whilst Years 5 and 6 are entering through the Brighton Road gate.

### **PE Kit on PE Days**

This year we are asking children to come into school dressed in their PE kits on their PE days, and remain in their kits all day thus not needing to change their clothing during the school day.

PE days are as follows:

Year 3: Monday and Wednesday

Year 4: Tuesday and Friday

Year 5: Tuesday and Friday

Year 6: Wednesday and Thursday

There will be some weeks when certain year groups will have a PE lesson on a Monday instead. This is because we have a Sports Coach who is available to teach classes on a Monday to provide time for teachers to work with individual children in a 'catch up' capacity. In the weeks where there is a change to the above PE days due to this, we will communicate to you via the VLE and email. We will also share the timetable with Class reps who will be on hand with WhatsApp reminders.

#### **Class Information Meetings**

Due to current restrictions we will not be holding in-school Class Information Meetings. Instead the teachers are preparing videos to share key information. These will be accessible via the school website from the week beginning 14.09.20.

## **Class / Learning Organisation**

- Children are asked to bring in their own supply of stationery so that they do not need to share.
- Homework: to reduce the traffic of paper and books between home and school we will be temporarily restricting our homework provision. More information to follow.
- Reading books: as above, we will not be having reading books travelling between home and school. The
  children will have an in-school reading book and an at-home reading book. We won't be using Reading
  Record books yet.

## **School Organisation**

- We are following the NHS Test and Trace guidance. In the event of a case in school we will close down that child's class, and possibly the other year group class as well. We will update you as and when we need to about any confirmed cases of Covid within the school community.
- Please note that the Boatie play equipment is not to be used by any children before or after school.

#### **Parents on School Site**

- Thank you for keeping your presence on school site to an absolute minimum. This helps us all to avoid unnecessary contact. If you wish to contact the school office or your child's teacher please do so via email. - After school clubs: a range of external clubs will be running, all with appropriate risk assessments and procedures in place. We will write to you at the end of this week with details of these clubs and the practical arrangements for each club.
