Dear Year 4 Parents and Carers

Year 4 Level 1 Surrey County Council (SCC) Cycle Training Course

Surrey County Council's Road Safety Team will be offering our Year 4 children Level 1 Cycle Training in school at the start of the summer term on Wednesday 27th, Thursday 28th and Friday 29th April 2022. This training is a great opportunity for the children to improve their cycling balance and control skills taking place in a trafficfree area on the school playground. The instructors are accredited to the National Standard for Cycle Training, are trained in basic first aid and have enhanced DBS clearance.

Each child will have the opportunity to take part in a 3 hour course on one of the days above starting at 9.00am and finishing at 12.15pm with a break about 10.30am. All the instructors will conform to Covid government guidance/risk assessment. The children will be placed by class in groups of up to 10 children - two groups taking part per day over the three days.

Encouraging children to get into the habit of cycling is a great way to support a healthy lifestyle and environmentally friendly way of transport. The County Council has given careful thought about how to support the recovery of the county from Covid-19 and is making extra support available to cycle training in reducing the Level 1 training cost from £15.50 to £9.25 per child which includes the admin cost, training and a certificate. Pupils eligible for free school meals receive a discount and pay £4.00.

Please read and sign page 2 of the attached consent form returning to the school office by email, or in an envelope via the class teacher, with payment via Parentmail PMX ideally by Friday 1st April and latest by Friday 22nd April 2022...

We will notify you of the group/day your child has been allocated to undertake the training after the Easter holiday. The children should bring their cycle and helmet to school on their allocated day - please bring a lock to secure their cycle in the cycle shed during the day. The children should come to school in uniform and change into PE kit/tracksuit (unless the training takes place on a PE day) as comfortable clothing is recommended. Please bring waterproofs as the training may take place in wet weather.
