Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find attached details of the after school clubs that are happening in the Summer Term 2022. There is also an electronic version of this list on our school website (under 'Pupils & Learning' / 'Clubs') together with electronic copies of the club flyers.

Start dates vary from club to club, so please do look at the clubs list for more detail. The club leader manages all bookings directly and their contact details can be found on the clubs list. Club bookings cannot be made through the school office. The only exception to this is Year 5/6 netball and Year 5/6 cricket. An electronic version of the permission slip is attached – please complete and e mail to the school office.

If your child wishes to attend a club, and you would like to talk about financial support for this, please do not hesitate to contact myself, or Mr Catchpole, in confidence. Our club provision is inclusive and open to all children; we would not want finances to be a barrier for any child wishing to take part.

Please do also remind your children about the lunchtime clubs on offer:

- Year 6 Prefect led clubs – The drama club, ably led by some Year 6 prefects, ran successfully in the Spring term and will continue into Summer. The Prefect led Comic Club has finished, but the Year 6 children are always willing to run activities so please do encourage your children to let me know if there is something they would like to take part in at lunchtimes. Some year 6 children are currently planning a lunchtime basketball club - further announcements in assembly to come!
- Sporting activities – our Sports team of Bill Bingham and Claire Parsons will continue to lead sports based activities for different year groups each day at lunchtimes. Again, there is no need to sign up; children can just turn up. Over the term we often focus on specific cohorts (e.g. Y3 girls, Y4 boys).
- The Nurture room – a quiet space for children who don't always want to be part of the hustle and bustle of the playground. This is based in the Learning Lab where there will be jigsaws, colouring and comics for children to access as and when they choose.
- Hall Club – this is an opportunity to use some of our indoor equipment and play games such as table tennis, ten pin bowling and to use the scooters. Each year group will have the option to attend Hall Club one day a week.
- Homework Club – this will be a drop-in club where children can come and ask for help with their homework on a Wednesday lunchtime in the IT suite. All year groups welcome as and when they need help.

You will notice that Mrs McAdam's Art hour has come to an end as she is now focussing her time elsewhere on other exciting projects. We would like to extend our thanks to Mrs McAdam for running this club and also to ask if there are any other parents with an artistic background who would consider offering an art club to our pupils. Do please get in touch if this might be you!
