

Parking Notice - Tuesday 13th December

We have been asked to inform you that next Tuesday 13th December there is a clash between the Prime Time Carol Service at Busbridge Church and one of the Infant School nativity performances which is at 2.30pm. Please can we advise you that the village hall car park will be out of use for parents on Tuesday afternoon as the village hall have kindly agreed for it to be used as an overflow car park for Prime Time members. Traffic and parking may therefore be more difficult on this day, and you may need to make alternative arrangements at pick up time when collecting your children from school.

We are aware that difficulties with traffic and parking have been a long term and on-going issue. Please can we ask you ensure you arrive in plenty of time for pick-up and, if possible, park away from the school and walk. Please can you also make sure that you do not stay stationary in your car or leave your car unattended on the school roundabout so that it will block the school entrance or other drivers, and potentially cause dangerous tailbacks on the Brighton Road. Please can you also use the village hall car park considerately as it, like the road and roundabout, is not school property. The school pays an annual donation of £300 to the village hall committee so that the parents may have the convenience of using the car park during drop off and pick-up, when not in use by hirers. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

We are very excited that our school choir will be performing this evening at school with the Godalming Community Gospel Choir. The choir will also be singing tomorrow, on Saturday 10th December, at the Churches Together Town Day at The Pepperpot in Godalming High Street. If you are able to come and listen to them sing we would love you to join us at 2.20pm.
