## Dear Year 5 Parents and Carers

## Year 5 trip to Rural Life Living Museum at Tilford, Farnham – Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2021

As part of our Victorian topic, we have in previous years taken the children to Preston Manor and Hove Museum in Brighton but unfortunately this trip is unable to go ahead this year as the venue is currently not taking bookings. However, we are delighted to inform you that we have organised an alternative trip for a Victorian day to the **Rural Life Living Museum at Tilford, Farnham on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> November**. Both the Rural Life Museum and the coach company have provided comprehensive risk assessments in line with Covid restrictions to ensure the trip adheres to the current requirements.

We will travel by coach leaving school at about 9.00am and returning back to school by 3.30pm. Children should arrive at school 5 minutes before registration time to register ready to leave school promptly at 9.00am. We should return back in time (traffic permitting) to finish the school day at the usual time of 3.30pm.

The children will be in their class groups and each group will participate in 2 activities - a Victorian schoolroom and a wheelwright activity. Both groups will also take a short diesel train ride around the site stopping halfway to explore the inner mechanics and engineering of the train.

It is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of **£18.20** per pupil towards the transport and trip costs. Although no pupil will be omitted from the visit on the grounds of cost, if there are insufficient funds the trip could be cancelled.

# All the children are required to bring a **named packed lunch and water bottle drink with them on the trip in a suitable backpack**.

On the day we are asking the children dress up as Victorians. They will need to **wear a suitable costume on this trip** as it will help the children get into role. The costume does need not be elaborate and here are some suggestions:

GIRLS	BOYS
Plain long sleeved top	Flat cap
White apron / pinafore apron	Simple waistcoat or short jacket
Plain dark skirt	Collarless shirt
Plain dark tights	Trousers tucked into long socks / old trousers cut off below the knee
Black shoes or boots	Black shoes or boots

**NB**: Please make sure that your child **wears a vest or T-shirt underneath a warm jumper with their Victorian costumes** as some areas at the Rural Life Museum are outdoors so the children can get cold. Please can you ensure your child also brings **a suitable waterproof coat and footwear eg. wellingtons in case of rain**.

Please complete the permission fom below and return with payment back to school **by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November 2021** making payment via Parentmail. If you have any queries regarding alternative payment method please contact Mrs Carter in the school office.

This trip is a great opportunity for the children to learn about life in Victorian times and we look forward to an enjoyable trip.
