Busbridge CE Junior School's 150th Anniversary – 1st March 2018: This is an exceptional year for our school as we officially turn 150 years old! On 1st March 1868 the school opened its doors to local children for the very first time, and there are plans afoot to commemorate this in ways which bring the past history of the school alive for the children, celebrate the present and look forward to the future. We are hoping to fund some of these activities via the Friends – we will keep you posted!

FUNDRAISING UPDATE

What we raised:

Last term we raised £1,950 from the Fireworks Extravaganza, £3,600 from the Christmas Fair and £500 from Phil the Bag and other schemes. That's a grand total of £6,000 already this school year - huge thanks to everyone who participated.

What we have spent:

We have already bought two interactive 'clever touch' style screens for classes 3B and 4W at a cost of £4,600. They have made a huge difference to the children's classroom learning.

What we are fundraising for:

- 1. We need to replace three more interactive screens, in 3G, 4L and 6E, so that even more of the classrooms have access to the latest in learning technology.
- 2. In line with his mission to raise participation and team spirit in sport across the school, Mr Catchpole would also like help with purchasing a Busbridge sports kit for the Lower School there is already a kit available for the Upper School.
- 3. We need new reading books for the classrooms and the library there are already plans to raise funds for this (see below).
- 4. The Y4 cloakrooms suffer from having too many pupils scrambling for their belongings in too small a space, which discourages the children from respecting their own and other people's property. The plan is to put lockers in this area so that the space is made much more useable.

Bouncing for Books – Friday 23rd March: We hope your children are still full of beans by the end of this term, as we will be holding another of our lively sponsored 'Bouncing for Books' events. The school hall will be turned into a soft play zone for the morning as the children bounce as many times

as they can on bouncy castles to raise funds to replace old and worn reading books for the classrooms and library. More info and sponsorship forms to follow later in the term.
