Height and weight checks for children in Year 6 – Tuesday 9th November 2021 at 9.15am

Each year in England, school children in Year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme. Height and weight measurements are used to calculate weight status. To find out more about the programme and how the data will be used, please visit www.nhs.uk/live-well/healthy-weight/national-child-measurement-programme/

During the Autumn term School nurses or health care providers weigh and measure children fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils.

To carry out these checks we need to have your consent and we use e-consents in the same way as we do for immunisations.

E-consent is quicker and easier for you and can be completed on any device i.e., mobile phone, tablet, or computer.

Children do not have to take part on the day if they do not want to.

What you need to do

Complete the electronic consent form.

Even if you do not wish your child to be measured, please complete the e-consent form so we can record your preference.

- Complete the boxes
- Select the consent section with *Yes* or *No* as appropriate

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent form from Cinnamon Digital Applications (who host the website for us). If you do not receive this, please check your junk email.

We will be sending your child's measurements to you using the email address you enter via the e- consent application. Please note that if your child is a healthy weight there will be no further contact from the School Nursing team.

If your child's weight falls outside predicted norms for their age and height, we will contact you.
