UPGRADING THE ICT SUITE

- The PTA agreed it was a good idea to use money in the account and create a positive impact for the school.
- Richard suggested the school can top up the £2.5k difference, and the PTA agreed they will pay this back to the school over the next academic year, as more fundraising events will hopefully take place.
- As the upgrade work will be messy and intrusive, it is ideal to do the ICT upgrade over the summer holidays.
