Pick-Up and Drop-Off at School

Just a gentle reminder, that to ease the flow of traffic at drop off and pick up times, we would be grateful if cars could not stop or park on the approach to school (on the roundabout), to let children out or pick them up. This often causes a tail back of traffic on Brighton Road. Parking on the zig-zag lines approaching the pedestrian crossing is also not permitted—this is for the safety of your children and for everyone in the local area. Please can children either be dropped off/collected from the village hall car park (in the allowed times) or alternatively, please park considerately away from school and walk the remainder of the school-run.

MUGA

The children are having a wonderful time on our new Multi Use Games Area (MUGA). So far we have played basketball, football, hockey, as well as hosting our weekly after school Athletics, Hockey and Football clubs. It is great to have this facility, and we are extremely grateful to Godalming Town Council and the Friends of Busbridge Junior School for funding the project. We are also indebted to our Governing Body, who have supported us with the project, in particular Matt Rooke, the Chair of our Resources Committee, who has given many, many hours of his time, and without whom the MUGA simply would not have happened.

The MUGA will be officially opened by the Mayor of Godalming at 1.45pm on Tuesday 26th September 2023. We are looking forward to welcoming him to the school to see what a great facility we have. The opening ceremony will last for about 30 minutes, and parents are welcome to join us.

Fundraising – we are working out our final costs on the MUGA but there will be a small balance that we still need to cover, in the region of £6100. Summer works

A **lot** of works took place on the school site over the holidays. As well as the installation of the multi-use games area, we were delighted to give the Year 4 block a fresh lick of paint —the classrooms are now looking very smart. The Year 6 block received new internal doors, intumescent paint in the corridors and library, and fire compartmentation in the loft space. Projects planned within the next 12 months include resurfacing of the Boaty play structure, replacement school entrance gates and replacement of the school boilers with air sourced heat pumps, as well as upgraded lighting. The majority of our planned projects are funded by the Diocese of Guildford, with the boiler project funded via the government's Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme. More details will follow on this in 2024.
