SIAMS Inspection - Wednesday 8th May 2019


On Wednesday 8th May we welcome Mrs Sally Jenkins to our school to lead us through our SIAMS inspection. A SIAMS inspection focuses on the impact of a school's Christian vision on pupils and adults. This involves looking at the school's Christian vision, the provision the school makes because of this vision and how effective this provision is in enabling all pupils to flourish. This is all explored through seven strands:

Vision and Leadership ; Wisdom, Knowledge and Skills ; Character Development: Hope, Aspiration and Courageous Advocacy ; Community and Living Well Together ; Dignity and Respect ; The impact of collective worship ; The effectiveness of religious education.
